9	Relating to Jefferson County; to prohibit the
10	possession of a trigger activator; and to establish civil
11	penalties for a violation.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. (a) This section shall apply only in
14	Jefferson County.
15	(b) For the purposes of this section, the following
16	terms have the following meanings:
17	(1) FIREARM. The term as defined in Section 13A-8-1,
18	Code of Alabama 1975.
19	(2) TRIGGER ACTIVATOR. Any part or combination of parts
20	designed and intended for use in converting or enabling a
21	firearm to shoot automatically more than one shot without
22	manual reloading by a single function of the trigger.
23	(c) No person shall knowingly have in his or her
24	possession, control, care, or custody a trigger activator.
25	(d) A person who violates subsection (c) is liable for
26	a civil penalty of not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000)
27	for each violation. The penalty may be assessed by the local
28	district attorney or the Attorney General and may be collected



29 by civil action.

30 (e) This section does not apply to any of the 31 following:

32 (1) A state or local law enforcement officer while33 acting in an official capacity.

34 (2) A person who lawfully has in his or her possession,
 35 control, care, or custody a trigger activator pursuant to
 36 federal law.

37 (3) Any trigger activator designed or intended to
38 increase a firearm's rate of fire but that does not enable a
39 semiautomatic firearm to fire more than two shots, without
40 manual reloading, by a single function of the trigger.

41 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October42 1, 2025.
