8 SYNOPSIS: Currently, there is not a period during a
9 calendar year in which firearms, ammunition, and
10 firearm supplies are exempt from sales tax.

11 This bill would for a limited period each
12 year exempt firearms, ammunition, and firearm
13 supplies from state sales and use tax.

19 Relating to sales and use tax on firearms,
20 ammunition, and firearm supplies; to exempt for a limited
21 period each year firearms, ammunition, and firearm supplies
22 from state sales and use tax.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. Firearms, ammunition, and firearm
25 supplies are exempt from state sales and use tax during the
26 period from 12:01 a.m. on the last Friday of the first full

1 weekend prior to Independence Day, the Fourth of July, and
2 ending at 12:00 midnight the following Sunday.

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective following
4 its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise
5 becoming law.
