A RESOLUTION

1 Establishing a House Special Committee on Military and Veterans' Affairs.

2 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

WHEREAS a large number of state residents currently serve in the military forces,
work for the military, or are veterans, and the military plays a vital role in the economy of the
state; and

6 WHEREAS there is a need for a comprehensive review of issues involving military
7 and veterans' affairs;

8 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that the House Special 9 Committee on Military and Veterans' Affairs is established to study issues, review laws, and 10 propose legislation relating to military and veterans' affairs; and be it

- FURTHER RESOLVED that the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint the members and designate a member or members to chair the committee; and be it
- 14 FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Special Committee on Military and 15 Veterans' Affairs may meet during and between sessions of the Twenty-Ninth Alaska State 16 Legislature and is terminated on the convening of the First Regular Session of the Thirtieth
