17 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2015-2016 FISCAL

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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Education - Arkansas School for the Blind for the 2015-2016
26 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

34 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department
35 of Education - Arkansas School for the Blind for the 2015-2016 fiscal year,
36 the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known

1 as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes:
 2 seventeen (17) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay
 3 not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation
 4 Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

 6 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
 7 appropriated, to the Department of Education - Arkansas School for the Blind,
 8 to be payable from the School for the Blind Fund Account, for personal
 9 services and operating expenses of the Department of Education - Arkansas
 10 School for the Blind - State Operations for the fiscal year ending June 30,

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32 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - BRAILLE AND LARGE PRINT TEXTBOOKS. There is
 33 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Arkansas School for the
 34 Blind, to be payable from the School for the Blind Fund Account, for
 35 purchasing, copying, and shipping Braille and large print textbooks for the
 36 blind and visually impaired students attending the public schools in Arkansas

1 by the Department of Education - Arkansas School for the Blind - Braille and
 2 Large Print Textbooks for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the
 3 following:

9 SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - BUILDING DEMOLITION AND ENVIRONMENTAL CLEAN-
 10 UP. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Arkansas
 11 School for the Blind, to be payable from the cash funds as defined by
 12 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Education - Arkansas School for
 13 the Blind, for maintenance and general operating expenses related to the
 14 demolition and environmental clean-up of the building located on the Blind
 15 School Grounds that was formerly occupied by Easter Seals Arkansas for the
 16 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the following:

23 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 25 PROVISION. Upon approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the
 26 Arkansas School for the Blind shall transfer appropriation from Item No.(08)
 27 Summer Projects, in Section 3 of this Act, to Item No. (01) through Item No.
 28 (05) in Section 3 of this Act, to compensate staff who work during the summer
 29 months on summer projects, and to cover other expenses of summer project
 30 activities. The Summer Projects line item may also be used for the annual
 31 cost related to the compensation of eligible staff for shift differential pay
 32 as well as compensation of employees for performance of duties assigned as
 33 referenced in Section 9 of this Act. Such additional compensation shall not
 34 be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 36 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

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 2 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
 4 ALLOWANCE. The Arkansas Schools for the Deaf and Blind may make special
 5 allowances available to any employee who performs one of the following duties
 6 in addition to their normal duties:

- 7 1) Teaching adult education classes, parent training, student tutorial
- 8 services on weekends or evenings
- 9 2) Coaching one or more sports
- 10 3) Sponsoring a club or organization that involves additional hours
- 11 outside of the normal working day
- 12 4) Interpretive Services

13 Compensation for additional duties may not exceed \$3,500 per school term for
 14 any one employee during each fiscal year. Such pay shall not be construed as
 15 exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said position.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 17 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

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 19 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

21 ADDITIONAL SALARY/COMPENSATION PROVISION. No employee drawing a salary or
 22 other form of compensation from the Arkansas Schools for the Deaf or Blind
 23 shall be paid an additional salary or receive additional compensation, other
 24 than reimbursement for actual expenses, from that agency, nor from any other
 25 agency or institution of higher education, except from the Superintendent's
 26 written certification to and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
 27 State that the work performed by the employee for the other position does not
 28 interfere with the proper and required performance of the employee's primary
 29 duties, and that the combined salary payments from both positions will not
 30 exceed the maximum annual salary for whichever of the two positions has the
 31 higher authorized maximum annual salary.

32 Any employee knowingly violating the provisions of this section shall be
 33 subject to immediate termination and shall be barred from employment by any
 34 agency or institution of the State of Arkansas for a period of not less than
 35 three (3) years or until such employee shall repay to the State of Arkansas
 36 any sums received by such employee in violation of this section, together

1 with interest at a rate of ten percent (10%) per annum.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 3 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

4
 5 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BRAILLE
 7 AND LARGE PRINT TEXTBOOKS. The State Board of Education shall make reasonable
 8 rules and regulations to implement the Braille and Large Print Textbooks
 9 appropriation and is hereby authorized to negotiate directly with publishers
 10 of Braille and Large Print Textbooks for the purchase of such textbooks. The
 11 Arkansas School for the Blind (ASB) is authorized to use funds from this
 12 account for costs associated with providing Braille Textbooks and Large Print
 13 Textbooks to public schools.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 15 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

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 17 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUMMER
 19 SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the regular
 20 school term, also work during summer months shall be authorized as additional
 21 compensation an amount not to exceed 1/12 of their annual salary for each
 22 month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall not be
 23 construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees.
 24 Payment of additional compensation shall be limited to employees in the
 25 following classifications:

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 36 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

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2 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CERTIFIED
4 MASTERS OR BACHELOR TEACHERS ENTERING STATE SERVICE. Upon the
5 superintendent's certification to the State Personnel Administrator of prior
6 service at an educational institution, the salary of teachers entering state
7 service as teachers for the sensory impaired may be adjusted to a rate of pay
8 closest to but not less than the annual salary they would have received from
9 their previous employer, effective upon employment at ASB.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
11 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

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13 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHER
15 SALARY INCREASE. In the event that an act is enacted in which the public
16 schools receive funds from the General Assembly to raise the salaries of
17 teachers employed in the public school districts, the Arkansas School for the
18 Deaf and the Arkansas School for the Blind shall be included.

19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
20 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

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22 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
24 RATES OF PAY. Due to the need to meet the minimum compensation schedule as
25 established by Act 74 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 84th General
26 Assembly, or its successor, for public school teachers, counselors, and
27 librarians and other education professionals as listed in subsection (a)
28 below, the Arkansas School for the Blind is authorized to adjust current or
29 new employees to at least the minimum level of compensation for public school
30 employees.

31 For current or new employees in the positions listed in subsection (a)
32 below, the Arkansas School for the Blind may implement salary adjustments to
33 maintain equity between their teacher salaries and those of Central Arkansas
34 Public School Systems only after a plan for determining and implementing
35 those adjustments has been reviewed by the Office of Personnel Management and
36 by the Personnel Committee of the Arkansas Legislative Council and approved

1 by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

2 For purposes of implementing the plan, the Arkansas School for the Blind
3 is authorized special rates of pay up to the maximum of the assigned grade
4 for classifications listed in subsection (a) below.

15 Funding for the minimum compensation provided for in this section that
16 is supported in whole or in part from general revenues, shall, if required,
17 be provided by a transfer from the Merit Adjustment Fund to the proper fund
18 or fund account and in such amounts as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer
19 of the State. The Arkansas School for the Blind shall, in addition to the
20 funds provided in this Act for Annual Career Service Recognition Payments
21 from the Merit Adjustment Fund, make available any funding generated from
22 agency salary savings for such purposes from the funds or fund accounts as
23 provided by law.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
25 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

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27 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
30 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 3 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 4 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9
 10 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
 11 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
 12 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 13 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
 14 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 15 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
 16 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
 17 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 18 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 19 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
 20 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
