 16 that are currently served by local district courts pursuant to § 16-17-901 et
 17 seq. shall be reorganized as state district courts and served by a state
 18 district court judge.

 20 section shall become effective January 1, 2017, and shall be placed on the
 21 ballot to be elected in the 2016 nonpartisan judicial election from the newly
 22 constructed judicial district.
