32 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by  
33 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly  
34 has determined that the State Plant Board may operate more efficiently if  
35 some flexibility is provided to the State Plant Board authorizing broad  
36 powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate

1 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of  
2 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this  
3 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint  
4 Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement  
5 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled  
6 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is  
7 void.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
9 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

10  
11 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA  
13 HELP PROVISION. No employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who is  
14 employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed 3/4 of the maximum  
15 annual salary for a comparable position as authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-  
16 201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor may such employee be employed for a  
17 period of time to exceed nine (9) months in any single fiscal year.  
18 Provided, however, that no employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who  
19 is employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed seventy five  
20 percent (75%) of the maximum annual salary for a comparable position as  
21 authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor  
22 shall such employee be employed for a period of time to exceed fourteen  
23 hundred (1400) hours in any single fiscal year.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
25 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

26  
27 SECTION 44. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
29 PROVISION. If the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary  
30 firefighters, dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a  
31 wildfire season, and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,  
32 appropriations may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees  
33 and Services to the proper character code for the employment of such  
34 personnel.

35 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air  
36 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and



1 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,  
2 excess appropriation in Regular Salaries or Personal Services Matching may be  
3 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in Section 3 and 30.

4 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for  
5 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is  
6 by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees  
7 for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the  
8 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation  
9 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in Section 3  
10 and 30.

11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
12 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

13  
14 SECTION 45. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO  
16 EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees  
17 to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission for  
18 expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees shall be  
19 deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a refund to  
20 expenditure.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
22 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

23  
24 SECTION 46. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
26 ALLOCATION RESTRICTIONS. The Secretary of the Arkansas Department of  
27 Agriculture shall at no time designate general revenue allocations to the  
28 State Plant Board, the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission and the  
29 Arkansas Forestry Commission at a level less than the revenue distribution  
30 provided in the Official Forecast of state general revenue in effect for each  
31 of those agencies.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
33 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

34  
35 SECTION 47. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING

1 REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Forestry Commission shall present the following  
2 data each month to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas  
3 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. This report shall be due by  
4 the 10th day of the month following the reporting period. The first reporting  
5 period shall be July 2012.

6 a) All fund transfers completed by the Arkansas Forestry Commission from  
7 any funding source including federal funds, and shall include a justification  
8 for the completion of the fund transfers.

9 b) All expenditures incurred by the Arkansas Forestry Commission from  
10 any funding source including federal funds, and shall include a justification  
11 for the expenditure of the funds.

12 c) All revenue receipts of the Arkansas Forestry Commission including  
13 but not limited to federal funds, general revenue, severance tax, acreage  
14 tax, timber sales and seedlings sales.

15 d) All Arkansas Forestry Commission activities including but not limited  
16 to, firefighting activities, fire prevention, and emergency response as it  
17 relates to the Commission's statutory mission provided in Arkansas Code 15-  
18 31-101.

19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
20 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

21  
22 *SECTION 48. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS*  
23 *CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.*

24 *PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish*  
25 *upon request for the Arkansas Agriculture Department a special Promotional*  
26 *Items appropriation to be used in the acquisition of promotional items.*  
27 *When the Arkansas Agriculture Department wishes to transfer from its*  
28 *operating expenses to the promotional items line, the request shall be*  
29 *forwarded by the Arkansas Agriculture Department to the Chief Fiscal Officer*  
30 *of the State for processing and for prior approval by the Arkansas*  
31 *Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Determining the maximum*  
32 *number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general*  
33 *revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the*  
34 *General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums*  
35 *in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue*  
36 *allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the*

1 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that  
2 the Arkansas Agriculture Department may operate more efficiently if some  
3 flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Agriculture Department authorizing  
4 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and  
5 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior  
6 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by  
7 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or  
8 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the  
9 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee  
10 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire  
11 section is void.

12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
13 2015 through June 30, 2016.

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15 SECTION 49. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
16 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
18 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
21 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
22 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

24  
25 SECTION 50. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

33  
34 SECTION 51. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
35 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
36 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

1 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of  
2 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
3 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
4 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm  
5 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
6 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
7 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
8 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
