1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 16 and 17 and substitute:

"18-12-116. Ammunition sales working group - ammunition delivery notification and labeling - penalties - definitions - repeal. (1) (a) The ammunition sales working group is created to study the regulation of retail ammunition sales and delivery. Upon request by the working group, the department of public safety shall provide staff services as necessary to implement this subsection (1).

- (b) The working group consists of eight members appointed no later than July 31, 2026, as follows: The president of the senate, speaker of the house of representatives, minority leader of the senate, and minority leader of the house of representatives shall each appoint one member of their legislative caucus and one person who represents the firearms and ammunition sales industry or delivery industry.
- (c) The nonlegislative members of the working group and, notwithstanding section 2-2-326, the legislative members of the working group serve without compensation and without reimbursement for expenses.
- (d) The executive director of the department of public safety shall convene the first meeting of the working group no later than September 30, 2026. The working group may meet remotely and shall meet as necessary to complete the recommendations required in this section.
- (e) On or before December 31, 2026, the working group shall submit recommendations to the general assembly for feasible regulations related to retail ammunition sales and changes to the regulation of delivery of ammunition sold at retail.
- 30 (f) This subsection (1) is repealed, effective July 1, 2027.".
- 31 Page 3, strike lines 1 through 19.
- 32 Page 5, after line 5 insert:
- "(c) "Working group" means the ammunition sales working
