"(6) IF AN INDIVIDUAL ATTEMPTS TO SELL OR TRADE A FIREARM TO A FEDERAL FIREARMS LICENSEE AND THE FIREARM IS DETERMINED TO BE STOLEN FOLLOWING A FIREARM SERIAL NUMBER CHECK PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, AND IF THE INDIVIDUAL BELIEVES OR HAS DOCUMENTATION TO SHOW THE FIREARM IS NOT STOLEN, THE INDIVIDUAL MAY APPEAL THE DETERMINATION TO THE DISTRICT COURT IN THE JURISDICTION WHERE THE INDIVIDUAL ATTEMPTED TO SELL OR TRADE THE FIREARM.".
