AN ACT CONCERNING CARRY PERMIT RECIPROCITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Attorney General
- 2 to negotiate and enter into agreements on behalf of the state of
- 3 Connecticut with the appropriate authorities of any state of the United
- 4 States, or any political subdivision thereof, granting reciprocity to any
- 5 person with a permit or certificate to carry a firearm, provided such state
- 6 or political subdivision has substantially similar standards for age,
- 7 background investigation and training as required by subsection (b) of
- 8 section 29-28 of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To secure permit or certificate reciprocity between Connecticut and other states that have substantially similar standards for carrying a firearm.
