AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM FOR SELF-DEFENSE AND HUNTING NEAR RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Emergency Services and Public Protection to adopt regulations to (1)
- 3 authorize an individual who owns a firearm to discharge such firearm
- 4 for self-defense purposes within five hundred feet of a residential
- 5 building, and (2) prohibit hunting within five hundred feet of such a
- 6 building.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect and clarify an individual's right to use a firearm in self-defense around such individual's home.
