**"AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FIREARM
INDUSTRY RESPONSIBILITY ACT, FIREARMS PERMITS AND
ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES AND SELF-DEFENSE."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (b) of section 28-1a of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*
5 *1, 2025*):

6 (b) The commissioner shall be responsible for: (1) Coordinating with
7 state and local government personnel, agencies and authorities and the
8 private sector to ensure adequate planning, equipment, training and
9 exercise activities by such personnel, agencies and authorities and the
10 private sector with regard to homeland security; (2) coordinating, and
11 as may be necessary, consolidating homeland security communications
12 and communications systems of the state government with state and
13 local government personnel, agencies and authorities, the general
14 public and the private sector; (3) distributing and, as may be

15 appropriate, coordinating the distribution of information and security
16 warnings to state and local government personnel, agencies and
17 authorities and the general public; [and] (4) establishing standards and
18 security protocols for the use of any intelligence information; and (5)
19 holding and maintaining a federal firearms license in order to facilitate
20 firearms transfers from person to person in compliance with the rules
21 established by the federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms
22 governing such transfers."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
