## "AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSPARENCY IN EDUCATION."

1 Strike section 72 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

"Sec. 72. Section 10-233m of the general statutes is repealed and the
following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2023*):

4 Each local or regional board of education that assigns a school 5 resource officer to any school under the jurisdiction of such board shall enter into a memorandum of understanding with a local law 6 7 enforcement agency regarding the role and responsibility of such school 8 resource officer. Such memorandum of understanding shall (1) be 9 maintained in a central location in the school district and posted on the Internet web site of the school district and each school in which such 10 school resource officer is assigned, (2) include provisions addressing 11 12 daily interactions between students and school personnel with school 13 resource officers, and [shall] (3) include a graduated response model for 14 student discipline. Any such memorandum of understanding entered

15	into, extended, updated or amended on or after July 1, 2021, shall
16	include a provision that requires all school resource officers to complete,
17	while in the performance of their duties as school resource officers and
18	during periods when such school resource officers are assigned to be at
19	the school, any separate training specifically related to social-emotional
20	learning and restorative practices provided to certified employees of the
21	school pursuant to sections 10-148a and 10-220a. For the purposes of this
22	section, "school resource officer" means a sworn police officer of a local
23	law enforcement agency who has been assigned to a school pursuant to
24	an agreement between the local or regional board of education and the
25	chief of police of a local law enforcement agency."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
