30	Sec. 2. (a) On March 3, 2020, the Council passed the Ghost Guns Prohibition Emergency
31	Amendment Act of 2020, effective March 11, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-245; 67 DCR 3086) ("emergency
32	act"), which expires on June 9, 2020.
33	(b) On March 17, 2020, the Council passed the Ghost Guns Prohibition Temporary
34	Amendment Act of 2020, enacted on March 31, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-276; 67 DCR 3945)

35 ("temporary act"), which is undergoing congressional review and is projected to take effect August
36 1, 2020.

- 37 (c) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the
 38 expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.
- 39 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
 40 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Ghost
 41 Guns Prohibition Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2020 be adopted after a
 42 single reading.
- 43 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
