4 Remove lines 1121-1156 and insert:

5 (4)~~(5)~~ POSSESSION IN PRIVATE CONVEYANCE.—

6 (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), notwithstanding  
7 subsection (2), it is lawful and is not a violation of s. 790.01  
8 for a person 18 years of age or older to possess a concealed  
9 firearm or other weapon for self-defense or other lawful purpose  
10 within the interior of a private conveyance, without a license,  
11 if the firearm or other weapon is securely encased or is  
12 otherwise not readily accessible for immediate use. Nothing in  
13 this paragraph ~~herein contained~~ prohibits the carrying of a

14 legal firearm other than a handgun anywhere in a private  
15 conveyance when such firearm is being carried for a lawful use.  
16 Nothing in this paragraph herein contained shall be construed to  
17 authorize the carrying of a concealed firearm or other weapon on  
18 the person. This paragraph subsection shall be liberally  
19 construed in favor of the lawful use, ownership, and possession  
20 of firearms and other weapons, including lawful self-defense as  
21 provided in s. 776.012.

22 (b)1. A person may not store a firearm, loaded or  
23 unloaded, in an unoccupied, unsecured private conveyance or  
24 vessel unless the firearm is kept from ordinary observation and  
25 view and locked within a trunk, utility or glove box, or another  
26 locked container or secured with a device or mechanism that is  
27 securely affixed to the private conveyance or vessel.

28 2. As used in subparagraph 1., the term:

29 a. "Private conveyance" includes any "motor vehicle" as  
30 defined in s. 790.251(2)(b) other than a public conveyance.

31 b. "Unsecured" means a private conveyance interior or  
32 vessel interior that is unlocked or otherwise left open to  
33 entry.

34 c. "Vessel" has the same meaning as provided in s. 327.02.

35 3. A person who violates this paragraph commits a  
36 misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s.  
37 775.082 or s. 775.083.
