8 (1) A person is not subject to any administrative, civil,
 9 or criminal penalties for taking a bear with lethal force if:

10 (a) The person reasonably believed that his or her action
 11 was necessary to avoid an imminent threat of death or serious
 12 bodily injury to himself or herself or another, an imminent
 13 threat of death or serious bodily injury to a pet, or
 14 substantial damage to a dwelling as defined in s. 776.013(5);

15 (b) The person did not intentionally or recklessly place
 16 himself or herself or the pet in a situation in which he or she

18 paragraph (a); and

19 (c) The person notifies the commission within 24 hours
20 after using lethal force to take the bear.

21 (2) A bear taken under this section must be disposed of by
22 the commission. The person taking the bear may not possess,
23 sell, or dispose of the bear or its parts.
