**Section 6. Subsections (8) and (9) are added to section
316.20655, Florida Statutes, to read:**

316.20655 Electric bicycle regulations.—

(8) A local government may adopt an ordinance providing
one or more minimum age requirements to operate an electric
bicycle and may adopt an ordinance requiring an operator of an
electric bicycle to possess a government-issued photographic
identification while operating the electric bicycle.

28 identification while operating the motorized scooter or
29 micromobility device.
