MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1004 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 14, between lines 24 and 25, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 11. IC 12-21-5-10 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
3 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
4 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 10. **Subject to available funding,**
5 **the division may develop an application to provide funds to a**
6 **school maintained by a school corporation or a school corporation**
7 **on behalf of a school to obtain a federal Food and Drug**
8 **Administration approved opioid overdose reversal medication.**".
9 Page 140, between lines 23 and 24, begin a new paragraph and
10 insert:
11 "SECTION 140. IC 20-34-4.5-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.164-2023,
12 SECTION 55, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
13 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 1. (a) A school or a school corporation may:
14 (1) fill a prescription or statewide standing order for an
15 emergency medication; **and**
16 (2) store the emergency medication:
17 (A) if the prescription or statewide standing order is filled by
18 a school, in the school; or
19 (B) if the prescription or statewide standing order is filled by
20 a school corporation, in a school in the school corporation;
21 **and**

1 **(3) work in cooperation with an opioid overdose prevention
2 organization to carry out the purposes of this chapter;**

3 if a health care provider who is licensed in Indiana and whose scope of
4 practice includes the prescribing of medication writes the prescription
5 or the state health commissioner issues a statewide standing order for
6 the emergency medication for the school or school corporation.

7 (b) The school shall store the emergency medication in a safe
8 location in which only school employees have access.

9 SECTION 141. IC 20-34-4.5-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.164-2023,
10 SECTION 56, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
11 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 3. (a) A health care provider who is licensed in
12 Indiana and whose scope of practice includes the prescribing of
13 medication may:

14 (1) write; or

15 (2) transmit in an electronic format for an electronically
16 transmitted prescription;

17 a prescription, drug order, or protocol for an emergency medication for
18 a school or school corporation.

19 (b) **Except as provided in subsection (d),** the state health
20 commissioner or the state health commissioner's designee who is a
21 licensed prescriber may issue a statewide standing order, prescription,
22 or protocol for emergency stock medication for schools or school
23 corporations.

24 (c) A pharmacist licensed under IC 25-26 may dispense a valid
25 prescription, drug order, standing order, or protocol for an emergency
26 medication issued in the name of a school or school corporation.

27 (d) **The state health commissioner or the state health
28 commissioner's designee who is a licensed prescriber shall issue a
29 statewide standing order, prescription, or protocol for a federal
30 Food and Drug Administration approved opioid overdose reversal
31 medication, including nasal spray, for each:**

32 (1) school; or

33 (2) school corporation on behalf of each school.

34 The standing order, prescription, or protocol shall provide at least
35 two (2) individual doses of a federal Food and Drug Administration
36 approved opioid overdose reversal medication per school.".

37 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
