## HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

- 1       Page 114, between lines 16 and 17, begin a new paragraph and  
2       insert:  
3       "SECTION 67. IC 20-28-9-26, AS ADDED BY P.L.165-2021,  
4       SECTION 154, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
5       [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 26. (a) For each school year  
6       beginning after ~~June 30, 2022~~, **June 30, 2026**, if a school corporation  
7       determines that the school corporation cannot establish a minimum  
8       salary of ~~forty thousand dollars (\$40,000)~~ **sixty thousand dollars**  
9       **(\$60,000)** for each full-time teacher, the school corporation shall  
10      submit a report to the department explaining the school corporation's  
11      inability to meet the minimum threshold requirement.  
12      (b) A report submitted under this section must include an  
13      explanation of the financial challenges, with detailed data, that  
14      preclude the school corporation from meeting the minimum salary  
15      threshold required under subsection (a). The report must also describe  
16      the cost saving measures taken by the school corporation in attempting  
17      to meet the minimum salary threshold required under subsection (a).".  
18      Page 140, between lines 32 and 33, begin a new paragraph and  
19      insert:  
20      "SECTION 115. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026] **(a) There is**

1 appropriated from the state general fund to the department of  
2 education, for distribution to school corporations in the manner  
3 determined by the department of education, in the state fiscal year  
4 beginning after June 30, 2026, and ending before July 1, 2027, an  
5 amount sufficient to ensure that each full-time teacher in each  
6 school corporation receives the minimum salary of sixty thousand  
7 dollars (\$60,000) as provided in IC 20-28-9-26, as amended by this  
8 act.

9 (b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2027."

10 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
