

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 79, between lines 20 and 21, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"SECTION 42. IC 4-3-29 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
3	AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4	UPON PASSAGE]:
5	Chapter 29. Presidential Tariffs Impact Commission
6	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "commission" refers to the
7	Indiana presidential tariffs impact commission established by
8	section 2 of this chapter.
9	Sec. 2. The Indiana presidential tariffs impact commission is
10	established to study the impacts of the Presidential Executive
11	Order "Regulating Imports with a Reciprocal Tariff to Rectify
12	Trade Practices that Contribute to Large and Persistent Annual
13	United States Goods Trade Deficits" issued on April 2, 2025.
14	Sec. 3. (a) The commission consists of the following members:
15	(1) Four (4) individuals appointed by the governor who
16	represent agriculture, manufacturing, labor, and the
17	construction industry, respectively.
18	(2) One (1) member of the general public appointed by the
19	governor.
20	(3) Two (2) members of the Indiana state senate, one (1) from
21	each political party, appointed by the president pro tempore
22	of the senate.
23	(4) Two (2) members of the Indiana house of representatives,
24	one (1) from each political party, appointed by the speaker of
25	the house of representatives.
26	(b) Each legislative member of the commission serves a two (2)
27	year term ending June 30 of each odd-numbered year. A legislative
28	member of the commission may be reappointed to successive

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1	terms.
2	(c) The governor shall designate two (2) members appointed
3	under subsection (a)(1) to serve as the chairperson of the
4	commission and as the vice chairperson of the commission,
5	respectively.
6	Sec. 4. A vacancy on the commission must be filled by the
7	appropriate appointing authority.
8	Sec. 5. The appointing authorities shall appoint commission
9	members before June 1, 2025.
10	Sec. 6. The commission shall meet:
11	(1) for the first time before July 1, 2025; and
12	(2) at least four (4) times each year.
13	Sec. 7. The commission's business must be conducted during a
14	meeting held in compliance with IC 5-14-1.5.
15	Sec. 8. (a) A member of the commission who is not a state
16	employee is not entitled to the minimum salary per diem provided
17	under IC 4-10-11-2.1(b). The member is, however, entitled to
18	reimbursement for mileage, traveling expenses as provided under
19	IC 4-13-1-4, and other expenses actually incurred in connection
20	with the member's duties as provided in the state policies and
21	procedures established by the Indiana department of
22	administration and approved by the budget agency.
23	(b) Each member of the commission who is a state employee is
24	entitled to reimbursement for traveling expenses as provided under
25	IC 4-13-1-4 and other expenses actually incurred in connection
26	with the member's duties as provided in the state policies and
27	procedures established by the Indiana department of
28	administration and approved by the budget agency.
29	(c) Each member of the commission who is a member of the
30	general assembly is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage,
31	and travel allowances paid to legislative members of interim study
32	committees established by the legislative council. Per diem,
33	mileage, and travel allowances paid under this subsection shall be
34	paid from appropriations made to the legislative council or the
35	legislative services agency.
36	(d) Expenses paid under subsections (a) and (b) shall be paid
37	from appropriations made to the state agency designated to serve
38	as the staff agency for the commission under section 9 of this
39	chapter.
40	Sec. 9. The governor shall designate an agency of the executive
41	branch to serve as a staff agency for the commission.
42	Sec. 10. The commission shall:
43	(1) study the impacts of the presidential tariffs on Indiana's
44	economy; and
45	(2) annually report its findings and any recommendations
46	before November 1 of each year to the:

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(A) governor; and

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1	(B) general assembly in an electronic format under
2	IC 5-14-6.
3	Sec. 11. The commission expires on the earlier of:
4	(1) July 1, 2028; or
5	(2) the date that the presidential tariffs are officially
6	rescinded.".
7	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
