Specific records. Specifies which delinquency records are available to law enforcement.

3	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
4	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2025]: Sec. 5.5. The following records of the
5	juvenile court relating to a delinquency proceeding are available
6	without a court order to a law enforcement officer acting within
7	the scope of the officer's duties:
8	(1) The child's name and age.
9	(2) The nature of the delinquent act.
10	(3) The chronological case summary.
11	(4) Index entries, summonses, warrants, petitions, orders,
12	motions (excluding psychological or child abuse evaluations),
13	decrees, and photographs for specific adjudications.
14	The juvenile court shall cooperate with a law enforcement agency
15	to ensure that these records are accessible from the mobile
16	terminal of a law enforcement officer, and are otherwise available
17	to a law enforcement officer acting within the scope of the officer's
18	duties in a timely manner.".
