An Act to preserve 2nd Amendment Rights.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 131 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "license", in line 236, the
- 3 following words:- "and all rights and privileges".
- 4 SECTION 2. Paragraph (e) of said section 131 of said chapter 140 of the General Laws,
- 5 as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following
- 6 paragraph:-
- 7 On the day an application is submitted for renewal of a license, the licensing authority
- 8 shall issue a receipt of notification that a renewal application has been submitted and is pending
- 9 review. The receipt shall include the date the renewal application was submitted and the date of
- 10 expiration for the application, which shall be 180 days from the submission of the renewal
- 11 application. The receipt shall also recognize that all rights and privileges shall be preserved while
- 12 the renewal application is pending review.
- SECTION 3. Said section 131 of said chapter 140, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- striking out, in lines 236, 241, 269, 318 and 331, the figure "90" and inserting in place thereof
- 15 the following figure: 180.
