1.10	197.447, may carry a pistol as provided in this subdivision under any circumstances and in
1.11	any location in which a permit to carry is otherwise required. The veteran must possess the
1.12	original or a certified copy of the veteran's government form DD214 while carrying the
1.13	pistol. This form constitutes the legal equivalency of a permit to carry. The veteran is not
1.14	required to apply for a permit to carry, pay any fees, or demonstrate training in the safe use
1.15	of a pistol. All other provisions of this section and other laws relating to permits to carry
1.16	pistols apply to a veteran carrying under this subdivision.
