AN ACT

To amend chapter 210, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to firearms in foster homes.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 210, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 210.555, to read as follows:

2 **210.555. Any and all firearms and ammunition in a foster home shall be stored so**
3 **as to be inaccessible to children. Foster parents may store firearms and ammunition**
4 **together in the same area, container, or cabinet if the area, container, or cabinet is locked**
5 **and secured so that it is inaccessible to children. The department shall promulgate rules**
6 **and regulations to implement the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule,**
7 **as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in**
8 **this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the**
9 **provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536**
10 **are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to**
11 **chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are**
12 **subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule**
proposed or adopted after August 28, 2016, shall be invalid and void.
