# **LEGISLATIVE BILL 22**

### Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Engineers and Architects Regulation
- 2 Act; to amend section 81-3401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
- 3 to provide immunity to architects and professional engineers for
- 4 certain professional services performed during an emergency; to
- 5 harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-3401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 81-3401 Sections 81-3401 to 81-3455 and section 2 of this act shall
- 4 be known and may be cited as the Engineers and Architects Regulation Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) An architect or professional engineer licensed under
- 6 the Engineers and Architects Regulation Act who voluntarily and without
- 7 compensation, other than expense reimbursement, provides architectural,
- 8 <u>structural</u>, <u>electrical</u>, <u>mechanical</u>, <u>or other design professional services</u>
- 9 related to a declared national, state, or local emergency caused by a
- 10 <u>natural disaster, terrorist attack, or other similar disaster or</u>
- 11 catastrophic event, at the request of or with the approval of a national,
- 12 <u>state, or local public official, law enforcement official, public safety</u>
- 13 <u>official, or building inspection official believed by the architect or</u>
- 14 professional engineer to be acting in an official capacity, shall not be
- 15 <u>liable for any personal injury, wrongful death, property damage, or other</u>
- 16 loss of any nature related to the architect's or professional engineer's
- 17 acts, errors, or omissions in the performance of any architectural or
- 18 engineering services for any structure, building, facility, project,
- 19 <u>utility, equipment, machine, process, piping, or other system, either</u>
- 20 <u>publicly or privately owned.</u>
- 21 (2) The immunity provided in this section shall apply only to a
- 22 voluntary architectural or engineering service that occurs during the
- 23 emergency or within ninety days following the date of the emergency.
- 24 (3) Nothing in this section shall provide immunity for willful,
- 25 wanton, reckless, or intentional misconduct.
- 26 (4) For purposes of this section:
- 27 (a) Building inspection official means any appointed or elected
- 28 federal, state, or local official with executive responsibility to
- 29 <u>coordinate building inspection in the jurisdiction in which the emergency</u>
- 30 <u>or event has occurred;</u>
- 31 (b) Law enforcement official means any appointed or elected federal,

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1 state, or local official with executive responsibility to coordinate law

- 2 <u>enforcement in the jurisdiction in which the emergency or event has</u>
- 3 <u>occurred;</u>
- 4 (c) Public official means any federal, state, or locally elected
- 5 <u>official with executive responsibility in the jurisdiction in which the</u>
- 6 emergency or event has occurred; and
- 7 (d) Public safety official means any appointed or elected federal,
- 8 state, or local official with executive responsibility to coordinate
- 9 public safety in the jurisdiction in which the emergency or event has
- 10 <u>occurred</u>.
- 11 Sec. 3. Original section 81-3401, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 12 Nebraska, is repealed.
