15	concealed handgui	n permit that is valid under Article 54B of this Chapter, or who is exempt from
16	obtaining a permit	pursuant to that Article, if all of the following conditions apply:
17	(1)	The person possesses and carries a handgun on educational property other than
18		an institution of higher education as defined by G.S. 116-143.1 or a nonpublic,
19		postsecondary educational institution.
20	(2)	The educational property is the location of both a school and a building that is
21		a place of religious worship as defined in G.S. 14-54.1.
22	(3)	The weapon is a handgun.
23	(4)	The handgun is only possessed and carried on educational property outside in
24		one of the following circumstances:
25		<u>a.</u> <u>Outside</u> of the school operating hours.
26		<u>b.</u> At any time, in a building that is a place of religious worship while the
27		person is attending worship services, funeral services, wedding
28		ceremonies, Christenings, religious fellowships, and any other
29		sacerdotal functions in the building. For purposes of this subdivision,
30		the term "attending" includes ingress and egress between the building
31		and the designated parking area for the place of religious worship.
32	(5)	The person or persons in legal possession or control of the premises have not
33		posted a conspicuous notice prohibiting the carrying of a concealed handgun
34		on the premises in accordance with G.S. 14-415.11(c)."
35	SECT	ION 4. This act becomes effective December 1, 2025, and applies to offenses
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committed on or after that date.
