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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:							
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1902, is							
14	amended to read as follows:							
15	Section 1902. As used in this act the Bus Passenger Safety Act:							
16	1. "Bus" shall be defined as provided in Section 1-105 of Title							
17	47 means a vehicle designed to carry passengers that is part of a							
18	network of passenger vehicles for use by the public, running on a							
19	regular schedule of routes, times and fares;							
20	2. "Bus transportation company" or "company" means any person							
21	or governmental entity providing for-hire transport to passengers or							
22	cargo by bus upon the roads, streets, highways and turnpikes of this							
23	state, whether in interstate or intrastate travel;							
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3. "Deadly or dangerous weapon" includes means all weapons
 listed in Sections Section 1287 and 1289.3 through 1289.5 of this
 title, and any other weapon capable of inflicting serious bodily
 injury; provided, however, this shall not include a weapon carried
 for lawful self-defense in compliance with the provisions of the
 Oklahoma Self-Defense Act;

7 4. "Passenger" means any person served by the <u>bus</u>
8 transportation company and in addition to the ordinary meaning of
9 passenger, the term shall include persons accompanying or meeting
10 another who is transported by this company, any person shipping or
11 receiving cargo and any person purchasing a ticket or receiving a
12 pass; and

13 5. "Terminal" means a bus station or depot or any facility 14 operated or leased by or operated on behalf of a bus transportation 15 company. This term shall include a reasonable area immediately 16 adjacent to any designated stop along the route traveled by any 17 coach <u>bus</u> operated by a bus transportation company and parking lots 18 or parking areas adjacent to a terminal.

19SECTION 2.AMENDATORY21 O.S. 2011, Section 1903, is20amended to read as follows:

Section 1903. A. No person shall by force or violence, or threat of force or violence, seize or exercise control of any bus. Any person violating this subsection shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony, and shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned

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punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not more than twenty (20) years, or fined by a fine of not more than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

5 Β. In addition, no person shall intimidate, threaten, assault or batter any driver, attendant, guard or passenger of any bus with 6 7 intent to violate subsection A of this section. Any person violating this subsection shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a 8 9 felony, and shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned punishable by 10 imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not 11 more than ten (10) years, or fined by a fine of not more than Five 12 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment. 13 С. In addition, any person violating subsection A or B of this 14 section using a dangerous or deadly weapon shall, upon conviction, 15 be guilty of a felony, and shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned 16 punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of 17 Corrections for not more than twenty (20) years, or fined by a fine 18 of not more than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both

19 <u>such fine and imprisonment</u>.

D. No person, other than an authorized law enforcement officer, shall board a bus with a dangerous or deadly weapon concealed upon or about his person. Upon the discovery of any such item or material, the company may obtain possession and retain custody of such item or material until it is transferred to the custody of law

1	enforcement officers. Any person convicted of violating this
2	subsection shall be guilty of a felony, and shall, upon conviction,
3	be imprisoned for not more than ten (10) years, or fined not more
4	than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or both.
5	E. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm
6	or hurl or place in the path any missile at, into or within any bus,
7	terminal or other transportation facility. Such person shall, upon
8	conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of not more
9	than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or by imprisonment for not
10	more than five (5) years, or both.
11	SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1904, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 1904. It shall be unlawful to remove any baggage, cargo
14	or other item transported upon a bus or stored in a terminal without
15	consent of the owner of such property or the company, or its duly
16	authorized representative. Any person violating this section shall $_$
17	upon conviction, be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction, shall
18	be punished punishable by a fine of not more than Ten Thousand
19	Dollars (\$10,000.00), or imprisoned by imprisonment in the custody
20	of the Department of Corrections for not more than five (5) years,
21	or by both such fine and imprisonment.
22	The actual value of an item removed in violation of this section
23	shall not be material to the crime herein defined.
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1	SECTION 4.	This act	shall become	effective	November	1, 2016.
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
