NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.31 of Title 21, unless 21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 22 During their elected term of office, the following statewide or 23 federally elected officials may carry a firearm on his or her person 24 throughout the State of Oklahoma, while in the performance of

1 official duties of the office, if the person has successfully

2 completed a handgun qualification course pursuant to the provisions

- 3 of the Oklahoma Self Defense Act:
- 4 1. The Governor;
- 5 2. The Lieutenant Governor;
- 6 3. The State Auditor and Inspector;
- 7 4. The Secretary of State;
  - 5. The Attorney General;
    - 6. The State Treasurer;
- 7. The Superintendent of Public Instruction;
- 11 8. The Commissioner of Labor;
- 12 9. The Insurance Commissioner;
- 13 | 10. The Corporation Commissioners;
- 14 11. Members of the United States Senate serving the State of
- 15 Oklahoma; and

- 16 12. Members of the United States House of Representatives
  17 serving the State of Oklahoma.
- Provided, however, state or federal elected officials shall be
- specifically prohibited from carrying a firearm on any public or
- 20 private elementary or secondary school property that does not have a
- 21 policy that authorizes the carrying of firearms on the school
- 22 property, any college, university or technology center school
- property and any private property or property owned by a business
- 24 entity that specifically prohibits persons from carrying firearms on

1	the property as provided in Section 1290.22 of Title 21 of the
2	Oklahoma Statutes.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
