7	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 26 of
9	Article II of the Oklahoma Constitution; expanding the rights of citizens to keep and bear arms; updating statutory language; providing ballot title;
11	and directing filing.

13	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
14	2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
15	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
16	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
17	the following proposed amendment to Section 26 of Article II of the
18	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
19	Section 26. A. The <u>fundamental</u> right of a <u>each individual</u>
20	citizen to keep and <u>to</u> bear arms in defense of his home, <u>or her</u>
21	person, or property, or including handguns, rifles, shotguns,
22	knives, nonlethal defensive weapons and other arms in common use, as
23	well as ammunition and the components of arms and ammunition, for
24	self-defense, lawful hunting and recreation, in aid of the civil

1	power, when thereunto legally <u>lawfully</u> summoned, <u>or for any other</u>
2	legitimate purpose shall never be prohibited; but nothing herein
3	contained not be infringed.
4	B. This section shall not prevent the Legislature from
5	regulating the carrying of weapons enforcing or adopting narrowly
6	tailored time, place and manner regulations, or authorizing
7	political subdivisions to adopt and enforce such regulations, to
8	serve a compelling state interest.
9	C. No law shall impose registration or special taxation upon
10	the keeping of arms including the acquisition, ownership, possession
11	or transfer of arms, ammunition or the components of arms or
12	ammunition.
13	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
14	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
15	the following form:

18	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
19	This measure would amend Section 26 of Article 2 of the Oklahoma
20	Constitution. This measure would prevent infringement of the
21	fundamental right of a citizen to keep and bear arms. This
22	measure will not prevent the Legislature from adopting
23	regulations that serves a narrowly tailored compelling state
24	interest. This measure would prohibit the imposition of
