10	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act;
11	amending 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.2, which relates to certain definitions; modifying definitions for
12	concealed and unconcealed firearms; providing exceptions; defining terms; and providing an
13	effective date.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.2, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 1290.2.
20	DEFINITIONS
21	A. As used in the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act:
	1. "Completed application" means all fields are completed, all
22	questions are answered and the required signatures are present on
23	the application for a handgun license, and the required documents
24	

are attached to the application, including legible fingerprints, if applicable;

- 2. "Concealed handgun firearm" means a loaded or unloaded pistol or handgun firearm not openly visible to the ordinary observation of a reasonable person;
- "Unconcealed handgun firearm" or "open carry" means a loaded 6 or unloaded pistol or handgun firearm that is not held in the hand, 7 but rather is carried upon the person in a holster where the firearm 9 is visible, or carried upon the person using a scabbard, or on a 10 shouldered sling with the firearm located in a general vertical 11 position where the barrel of the firearm is safely pointed in an up 12 or down direction, or in a case designed for carrying firearms. The 13 provisions of this paragraph shall not apply while lawfully at a gun range, while lawfully hunting, during an act of self-defense, or 14 otherwise during lawful use of the firearm; and 15
  - 4. "Pistol" or "handgun" shall have the same definition as provided in the Oklahoma Firearms Act of 1971, defined in Section 1289.3 of this title;
  - 5. "Rifle" shall have the same definition as provided in Section 1289.4 of this title; and
- 21 <u>6. "Shotgun" shall have the same definition as provided in</u>
  22 <u>Section 1289.5 of this title.</u>

1	B. The definition of pistol or handgun for purposes of the
2	Oklahoma Self-Defense Act shall not apply to imitation pistols,
3	flare guns, underwater fishing guns or blank pistols.
4	C. Pistols, handguns, rifles, shotguns, and all other lawful
5	firearms mentioned in the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act may collectively
6	be referred to as "firearms".
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
