6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to handgun purchasing; amending 21
8 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.26, which relates to
9 reciprocal agreement authority; allowing for
10 concealed carry permits and licenses to serve as
11 identification and verification when purchasing
12 firearms in this state; and providing an effective
13 date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.26, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1290.26.

18 RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT AUTHORITY

19 The State of Oklahoma hereby recognizes any valid concealed or
20 unconcealed carry weapons permit, valid military identification card
21 as provided for qualified persons in Section 1290.8 of this title or
22 license issued by another state, or if the state is a nonpermitting
23 carry state, this state shall reciprocate under the permitting law
24 of that state.

1 A. Any person entering this state in possession of a firearm
2 authorized for concealed or unconcealed carry upon the authority and
3 license of another state or a valid military identification card as
4 provided for qualified persons in Section 1290.8 of this title is
5 authorized to continue to carry a concealed or unconcealed firearm
6 and license in this state; provided the license from the other state
7 or valid military identification card as provided for qualified
8 persons in Section 1290.8 of this title remains valid. The firearm
9 must either be carried unconcealed or concealed, and upon coming in
10 contact with any peace officer of this state, the person must
11 disclose the fact that he or she is in possession of a concealed or
12 unconcealed firearm pursuant to a valid concealed or unconcealed
13 carry weapons permit, license or a valid military identification
14 card as provided for qualified persons in Section 1290.8 of this
15 title issued in another state.

16 B. Any person entering this state in possession of a firearm
17 authorized for concealed carry upon the authority of a state that is
18 a nonpermitted carry state and the person is in compliance with the
19 Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, the person is authorized to carry a
20 concealed or unconcealed firearm in this state. The firearm must be
21 carried fully concealed, or unconcealed and upon coming in contact
22 with any peace officer of this state, the person must disclose the
23 fact that he or she is in possession of a concealed or unconcealed
24 firearm pursuant to the nonpermitting laws of the state in which he

1 or she is a legal resident. The person shall present proper
2 identification by a valid photo ID as proof that he or she is a
3 legal resident in such a non-permitting state. The Department of
4 Public Safety shall keep a current list of non-permitting states for
5 law enforcement officers to confirm that a state is nonpermitting.

6 C. Any person who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older
7 having a valid firearm license from another state may apply for a
8 handgun license in this state immediately upon establishing a
9 residence in this state.

10 D. Any resident of a state bordering this state shall be
11 authorized to present a concealed carry permit or license from that
12 bordering state as a sufficient form of identification and
13 verification to purchase a firearm in this state provided that the
14 purchase is otherwise in compliance with federal and state law and
15 that the laws and regulations provided in that bordering state
16 reciprocate the provisions of this section.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
