BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1004, as
amended by Section 1, Chapter 73, O.S.L. 2012 (59 O.S. Supp. 2014,
Section 1004), is amended to read as follows:
Section 1004. A. The Oklahoma State Committee of Plumbing
Examiners is hereby <del>re-created to continue until July 1, 2016, in</del>
accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law, as
provided by Section 3901 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
Statutes, created and shall consist of five (5) members, each of
whom shall be a citizen of the United States, and a resident of this
state. One member shall be appointed from each congressional

1 district and any remaining members shall be appointed from the state 2 However, when congressional districts are redrawn each at large. member appointed prior to July 1 of the year in which such 3 4 modification becomes effective shall complete the current term of 5 office and appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall be based on the redrawn 6 7 districts. Appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall be from any redrawn districts 8 9 which are not represented by a board member until such time as each 10 of the modified congressional districts are represented by a board 11 member. No appointments may be made after July 1 of the year in 12 which such modification becomes effective if such appointment would 13 result in more than two members serving from the same modified 14 Beginning January 1, 2002, as the terms of members district. 15 serving on the Committee on such date expire, members of the 16 Committee shall be appointed by the Construction Industries Board 17 which may also remove them for cause. They will hold office for 18 terms of two (2) years, or until their successors are appointed. 19 Two members of the Committee shall have had at least five (5) years' 20 practical experience as a licensed master plumber or plumbing 21 contractor, and two members shall have had at least five (5) years' 22 practical experience as a licensed journeyman plumber. One member 23 shall be a plumbing inspector selected from lists of names submitted 24 from plumbing inspection industries. Whenever appointments of

1 initial, new, or replacement plumbing members of the Committee are 2 to be made, the Board shall choose them only from lists of at least 3 three names to be furnished whenever needed as follows:

Master plumber or plumbing contractor member - lists to be
 furnished by associated plumbing and heating contractors of this
 state;

7 2. Journeyman plumber member - lists to be furnished by state
8 pipe trades associations;

9 3. One licensed master plumber or plumbing contractor who is 10 not a member of an association of plumbing, heating, and cooling 11 contractors of this state; and

One licensed journeyman plumber who is not a member of a
 state pipe trades association.

B. Duties of the Committee shall be to serve the Construction Industries Board in an advisory capacity, to formulate rules pursuant to The Plumbing License Law of 1955, and to assist and advise the Board on the examination of applicants for licenses as journeyman plumber or plumbing contractor, in accordance with such rules and the terms and conditions hereof. A majority of the Committee shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

C. Each examiner shall be reimbursed for travel expenses in
 accordance with the provisions of the State Travel Reimbursement
 Act, Section 500.1 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1SECTION 2.AMENDATORY59 O.S. 2011, Section 1006, is2amended to read as follows:

Section 1006. A. The Construction Industries Board shall issue
licenses to persons who have been certified by the Board as having
successfully passed the examination for journeyman plumber or
plumbing contractor, as the case may be, and who have paid the fees
and have otherwise complied with the applicable requirements of The
Plumbing License Law of 1955.

B. All licenses shall be nontransferable. It shall be unlawful
for any holder of a license under The Plumbing License Law of 1955
to loan or allow the use of such license by any other person, firm
or corporation, except as specifically provided in The Plumbing
License Law of 1955.

C. The Board shall adopt procedures and rules to review and accept proof and documentation of an applicant's qualified training and experience as a journeyman plumber or plumbing contractor while on active duty with the armed forces of the United States when such service member has been honorably discharged from active duty within one (1) year of the application for examination or licensure in this state as a journeyman plumber or plumbing contractor.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
