18	Section 53. A. Every parent who attempts to intentionally
19	conceal the existence of a child and maliciously deprives the other
20	parent of a right to custody or a right to visitation through the
21	denial of the existence of the child shall, upon conviction, be
22	guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the county
23	jail for a term not exceeding one (1) year, or by a fine not

1 <u>exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by both such fine and</u>
2 imprisonment.

3 B. Every woman person who, having been convicted of endeavoring 4 to conceal the birth of an issue of her body a child, which, if born 5 alive, would be a bastard, or the death of any such issue child under the age of two (2) years, subsequently to such conviction 6 7 endeavors to conceal any such birth or death of issue of her body, a child shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by 8 9 imprisonment in the State Penitentiary custody of the Department of 10 Corrections for a term not exceeding five (5) years and not less 11 than two (2) years. 12 C. In any proceeding regarding a violation of this section, the 13 defendant shall have the right to claim the affirmative defense of 14 "self-defense" or "defense of others" by providing evidence of 15 domestic abuse, as such term is defined in Section 644 of this 16 title, or sexual abuse, as such term is defined in Section 843.5 of 17 this title. 18 SECTION 2.
