WHEREAS, during Ms. Vrana's tenure in office, she was active in
the County Officers and Deputies Association as well as the County
Assessors and Deputies Association, holding every office in the
associations; and
WHEREAS, during those years, Ms. Vrana assumed a large role in
the enactment of the Ad Valorem Reform laws in the 1980s and was the
first Assessor to graduate from the mandatory educational
curriculum; and
WHEREAS, after retiring from county government, Ms. Vrana became
a licensed abstractor working for Creek County Abstract and Title
Company, prior to marrying her late husband, Chuck Vrana and moving
to Shawnee, Oklahoma; and
WHEREAS, Ms. Vrana is blessed with two children, Steven B. Jones
and Veronica White and two grandchildren, Tyler and Mallory. All
reside in the Sapulpa area where they were born and raised; and
WHEREAS, Ms. Vrana's journey in Elkdom began in the Sand Springs
Lodge where she served as Exalted Ruler. She additionally served
the Grand Lodge in the capacity of District Deputy to the Grand
Exalted Ruler as well as being elected Northeast District Vice-
President; and
WHEREAS, this year the focus of Ms. Vrana's committee on Safety
and Accident Prevention has been on responsible beverage service,
enlisting the aid of the ABLE Commission to provide an education
program at all four District Vice-Presidents' meetings; and

1	WHEREAS, Ms. Vrana, proud member of the Cushing-Drumright Lodge,
2	was elected President of the Oklahoma Elks Association for 2014-
3	2015, becoming the first female to hold this esteemed position; and
4	WHEREAS, during the ritual of initiation, President Vrana was
5	indelibly impressed by a particular passage: "As we therefore have
6	opportunity, let us do good to one another, for we pass this way but
7	once."; and
8	WHEREAS, it has always been President Vrana's goal to focus on
9	the good projects of the Elks, including service to veterans in
10	hospitals and homes, scholarships to worthy students, the Hoop Shoot
11	Contest which motivates and inspires young athletes, the Cadet
12	Lawmen Academy and Special Olympics, just to mention a few of the
13	Elks' worthwhile activities.
