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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 17 O.S. 2011, Section 801.4, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 801.4. A. The Legislature declares that it is in the
16	public interest to promote renewable energy development in order to
17	best utilize the abundant natural resources found in this state.
18	B. It is hereby declared the intent of the State of Oklahoma to
19	increase the use of renewable energy in the state by setting a
20	renewable energy standard that will serve as a goal to be reached by
21	the year 2015 <u>2020</u> .
22	C. There is hereby established a renewable energy standard for
23	the state that will serve as a goal for the year $\frac{2015}{2020}$. The
24	renewable energy standard shall be a goal that fifteen percent (15%)

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generation within the state by the year 2015 2020 be generated from 2 3 renewable energy sources. For purposes of this section, qualifying renewable energy 4 D. 5 resources shall include: 1. Wind; 6 2. 7 Solar; 3. Photovoltaic; 8 9 4. Hydropower; 5. Hydrogen; 10 11 6. Geothermal; 7. Biomass, which projects may include agricultural crops, 12 wastes, and residues, wood, animal and other degradable organic 13 wastes, municipal solid waste, and landfill gas; 14 8. Distributed generation from an eligible renewable energy 15 resource where the generating facility or any integrated cluster of 16 such facilities has an installed generating capacity of not more 17 than five (5) megawatts; 18 9. Other renewable sources approved by the Commission; and 19 Demand side management and energy efficiency as provided in 20 10. 7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
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
