19	A. The State Department of Health shall be under the Merit
20	System. Except as otherwise provided in subsection B of this
21	section or Section 840-5.5 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes or
22	except as otherwise provided by law, all offices, positions, and
23	personnel shall be classified and subject to the provisions of the
24	Merit System of Personnel Administration and rules promulgated

pursuant thereto. This section shall supersede and repeal any and
all executive orders issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Personnel Act
to place the agency or its predecessors under the Merit System.

- B. In addition to offices, positions, and personnel that are unclassified as specifically provided by law, the State Department of Health may place in the unclassified service any employee who is initially employed on or after July 1, 2015, in the following positions:
- 9 1. State Commissioner of Health;
- 10 2. Assistant State Commissioner of Health;
- 3. Senior Deputy Commissioner of Health;
- 12 4. Deputy Commissioner of Health;
- 13 5. Assistant Deputy Commissioner of Health;
