9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to firearms; amending 21 O.S. 2011,
11 Section 1290.5, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter
12 122, O.S.L. 2014 (21 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section
13 1290.5), which relates to the Oklahoma Self-Defense
14 Act; directing Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
15 to remit portion of renewal fee under certain
16 circumstances; directing deposit of fee into certain
17 account; and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.5, as
20 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 122, O.S.L. 2014 (21 O.S. Supp.
21 2017, Section 1290.5), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 1290.5

23 TERM OF LICENSE AND RENEWAL

24 A. A handgun license when issued shall authorize the person to
whom the license is issued to carry a loaded or unloaded handgun,
concealed or unconcealed, as authorized by the provisions of the

1 Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, and any future modifications thereto.
2 The license shall be valid in this state for a period of five (5) or
3 ten (10) years, unless subsequently surrendered, suspended or
4 revoked as provided by law. The person shall have no authority to
5 continue to carry a concealed or unconcealed handgun in this state
6 pursuant to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act when a license is expired
7 or when a license has been voluntarily surrendered or suspended or
8 revoked for any reason.

9 B. A license may be renewed any time within ninety (90) days
10 prior to the expiration date as provided in this subsection. The
11 Bureau shall send a renewal application to each eligible licensee
12 with a return address requested. There shall be a ninety-day grace
13 period on license renewals beginning on the date of expiration,
14 thereafter the license is considered expired. However, any
15 applicant shall have three (3) years from the expiration of the
16 license to comply with the renewal requirements of this section.

17 1. To renew a handgun license, the licensee must first obtain a
18 renewal form from the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

19 2. The applicant must complete the renewal form, attach two
20 current passport size photographs of the applicant, and submit a
21 renewal fee in the amount of Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00) to the
22 Bureau. The renewal fee may be paid with a nationally recognized
23 credit card as provided in subparagraph b of paragraph 4 of
24 subsection A of Section 1290.12 of this title, by electronic funds

1 transfer, or by a cashier's check or money order made payable to the
2 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

3 3. Upon receipt of the renewal application, photographs and
4 fee, the Bureau will conduct a criminal history records name search,
5 an investigation of medical records or other records or information
6 deemed by the Bureau to be relevant to the renewal application. If
7 the applicant appears not to have any prohibition to renewing the
8 handgun license, the Bureau shall issue the renewed license for a
9 period of five (5) or ten (10) years. If the Bureau requests the
10 sheriff to conduct a criminal history records name search for the
11 renewal application of an applicant, the Bureau shall remit fifty
12 percent (50%) of the renewal fee paid by the applicant to the
13 sheriff. Fees collected by the sheriff for conducting a criminal
14 history records name search at the request of the Bureau shall be
15 retained by the sheriff and deposited into the Sheriff's Service Fee
16 Account.

17 C. Beginning November 1, 2007, any person making application
18 for a handgun license or any licensee seeking to renew a handgun
19 license shall have the option to request that said license be valid
20 for a period of ten (10) years. The fee for any handgun license
21 issued for a period of ten (10) years shall be double the amount of
22 the fee provided for in paragraph 4 of subsection A of Section
23 1290.12 of this title. The renewal fee for a handgun license issued

1 for a period of ten (10) years shall be double the amount of the fee
2 provided for in paragraph 2 of subsection B of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
