6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending  
8 63 O.S. 2021, Section 4210.3, which relates to the  
9 Oklahoma Boating Safety Regulation Act; adding  
10 exception to certain prohibited act; modifying and  
11 reducing certain penalties; and providing an  
12 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 4210.3, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 4210.3 It shall be unlawful to ~~transport a shotgun,~~  
16 ~~rifle or pistol in or to~~ discharge ~~such weapons~~ a firearm from a  
17 vessel, except for the purposes of self-defense, hunting animals or  
18 fowl, and in compliance with existing state ~~and federal~~ laws.

19 Anyone violating the provisions of this section, upon conviction,  
20 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of  
21 ~~not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not more than One Hundred~~  
22 ~~Dollars (\$100.00),~~ or by imprisonment in the county jail for not  
23 ~~less than ten (10) days and not more than six (6) months~~ three (3)  
24 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. ~~Any person in~~

1 ~~possession of a valid handgun license from this state or a~~  
2 ~~reciprocal state authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act shall~~  
3 ~~not be deemed guilty of transporting a pistol in violation of this~~  
4 ~~section when a handgun is carried concealed or unconcealed upon or~~  
5 ~~about their person in compliance with the provisions of the Oklahoma~~  
6 ~~Self-Defense Act.~~

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
