At public events, the location within the event occupied by the small farm winery or winemaker licensee becomes a licensed premises and extension of the licensed small farm winery or winemaker. The licensee shall set up and define an area contiguous to its booth space as a serving area where the wine is dispensed. The licensee may only serve the wine in the serving area. In the event that multiple winemakers are at the same public event, they may combine their serving areas into one larger area as long as they are contiguous to the winemakers' booths."
