8 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to firearm suppressors; providing  
10 exemptions for firearms manufactured, sold and  
11 purchased in this state from federal laws and federal  
12 regulations; declaring firearm materials manufactured  
13 in Oklahoma exempt from federal regulation; requiring  
14 certain stamp on firearms manufactured and sold in  
15 Oklahoma; stating manufacturing requirements for  
16 firearms; prohibiting certain entities from adopting  
17 or imposing rules, ordinances, policies or  
18 restrictions regulating firearms that contravene  
19 state law; defining terms; providing for  
20 codification; and providing an effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.32 of Title 21, unless  
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A firearm that is manufactured in this state, sold and  
purchased in this state, and remains in this state shall not be  
subject to federal law or federal regulation including registration,

1 under the authority of the United States Congress to regulate  
2 interstate commerce.

3 1. A basic material from which a firearm is manufactured in  
4 this state including, but not limited to, any unmachined metal or  
5 plastic stock material, is not a firearm, and is not subject to  
6 federal regulation under the authority of the United States Congress  
7 to regulate interstate commerce as if it were a firearm.

8 2. A firearm manufactured and sold in this state must have the  
9 words "Made in Oklahoma" clearly stamped, machined, or engraved on  
10 it.

11 B. For purposes of this section, a firearm is manufactured in  
12 this state if the item is manufactured:

13 1. In this state from basic materials; and

14 2. Without the inclusion of any imported from another state.

15 C. No agency, municipality, or other political subdivision  
16 shall adopt a rule, order, ordinance, or policy under which the  
17 entity enforces an order, rule, or regulation that purports to  
18 regulate the manufacturing of firearms if the statute, order, rule,  
19 or regulation imposes a prohibition, restriction, or other  
20 regulation that does not exist under the laws of this state.

21 D. As used in this section:

22 1. The term "firearm" means any weapon which will or is  
23 designed to or may readily be converted to expel a projectile by the  
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1 action of an explosive, or the frame or receiver of any such weapon;  
2 and

3 2. "Manufacture" includes the assembling, modifying, or  
4 altering of a firearm, as well as stamping, forging, casting,  
5 machining, etching, engraving, painting, coating, or another process  
6 for working a material.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
