SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[*Requires*] Specifies requirements for course taken to demonstrate competence with handgun for person applying for concealed handgun license [to pass firing range test]. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 166.291 is amended to read:

6 166.291. (1) The sheriff of a county, upon a person's application for an Oregon concealed 7 handgun license, upon receipt of the appropriate fees and after compliance with the procedures set 8 out in this section, shall issue the person a concealed handgun license if the person:

9 (a)(A) Is a citizen of the United States; or

10 (B) Is a legal resident alien who can document continuous residency in the county for at least 11 six months and has declared in writing to the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services 12 the intent to acquire citizenship status and can present proof of the written declaration to the 13 sheriff at the time of application for the license;

- 15 (c) Is a resident of the county;
- 16 (d) Has no outstanding warrants for arrest;
- 17 (e) Is not free on any form of pretrial release;
- 18 (f) Demonstrates competence with a handgun by any one of the following:

(A) Completion of any hunter education or hunter safety course approved by the State Depart ment of Fish and Wildlife or a similar agency of another state if handgun safety was a component
 of the course;

(B) Completion of any National Rifle Association firearms safety or training course if handgun
 safety was a component of the course;

(C) Completion of any firearms safety or training course or class available to the general public
offered by law enforcement, community college, or private or public institution or organization or
firearms training school utilizing instructors certified by the National Rifle Association or a law
enforcement agency if handgun safety was a component of the course;

(2) A person who has been granted relief under ORS 166.274 or 166.293 or section 5, chapter 826, 32Oregon Laws 2009, or 18 U.S.C. 925(c) or has had the person's record expunged under the laws of 33 34 this state or equivalent laws of other jurisdictions is not subject to the disabilities in subsection 35 (1)(g) to (L) of this section. (3) Before the sheriff may issue a license: 36 37 (a) The application must state the applicant's legal name, current address and telephone number, 38 date and place of birth, hair and eye color and height and weight. The application must also list the applicant's residence address or addresses for the previous three years. The application must contain 39 a statement by the applicant that the applicant meets the requirements of subsection (1) of this 40 section. The application may include the Social Security number of the applicant if the applicant 41 42 voluntarily provides this number. The application must be signed by the applicant. (b) The applicant must submit to fingerprinting and photographing by the sheriff. The sheriff 43 shall fingerprint and photograph the applicant and shall conduct any investigation necessary to 44 corroborate the requirements listed under subsection (1) of this section. If a nationwide criminal 45

records check is necessary, the sheriff shall request the Department of State Police to conduct the 1 2 check, including fingerprint identification, through the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The Federal Bureau of Investigation shall return the fingerprint cards used to conduct the criminal records 3 check and may not keep any record of the fingerprints. The Department of State Police shall report 4 the results of the fingerprint-based criminal records check to the sheriff. The Department of State $\mathbf{5}$ Police shall also furnish the sheriff with any information about the applicant that the Department 6 $\mathbf{7}$ of State Police may have in its possession including, but not limited to, manual or computerized criminal offender information. 8

9 (4) Application forms for concealed handgun licenses shall be supplied by the sheriff upon re-10 quest. The forms shall be uniform throughout this state in substantially the following form:
