7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 4953. Retaliation against witness, victim or party.

10	(b) GradingThe offense is a felony of the third degree if
11	the retaliation is accomplished by any of the means specified in
12	section 4952(b)(1) [through (5)] (relating to intimidation of
13	witnesses or victims). Otherwise the offense is a misdemeanor of
14	the second degree.
15	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
