# RELATING TO STATE AFFAIRS AND GOVERNMENT -- COMMISSION ON STANDARDS AND TRAINING

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-28.2 of the General Laws entitled "Police Officers -

2 Commission on Standards and Training" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following

3 section:

#### 4 <u>42-28.2-8.3. Educational requirements -- Development disability recognition</u>

5 training. -- The commission on standards and training shall prepare and publish mandatory

6 training standards to provide instruction for police officers in identifying, responding to,

7 <u>handling, investigating and reporting all incidents involving any person with a "developmental</u>

8 disability" as defined in § 40.1-1-8.1. The commission shall include this training in all curricula

9 for recruits and in-service trainees, in all police academies operated or certified by the

10 commission.

SECTION 2. Section 40.1-1-8.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 40.1-1 entitled
"Department of Behavioral Healthcare, Developmental Disabilities and Hospitals" is hereby
amended to read as follows:

14 **<u>40.1-1-8.1. "Developmental disability" defined. --</u> The term "developmental disability"** 

15 means a severe, chronic disability of a person which:

16 (1) Is attributable to a mental or physical impairment or combination of mental and17 physical impairments;

18 (2) Is manifested before the person attains age twenty two (22) at any age;

- 1 (3) Is likely to continue indefinitely;
- 2 (4) Results in substantial functional limitations in three (3) or more of the following

3 areas of major life activity:

- 4 (i) Self-care;
- 5 (ii) Receptive and expressive language;
- 6 (iii) Learning;
- 7 (iv) Mobility;
- 8 (v) Self-direction;
- 9 (vi) Capacity for independent living; and
- 10 (vii) Economic self-sufficiency; and
- 11 (5) Reflects the person's need for a combination and sequence of special,
- 12 interdisciplinary, or generic care, treatment, or other services which are of life-long or extended
- 13 duration and are individually planned and coordinated.
- 14 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
