## **HOUSE BILL 2309**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-103 and Title 39, Chapter 17, Part 13, relative to the discharge of a firearm.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-103, is amended by designating the language of subsection (a) as (a)(1) and by adding the following new subdivision (2):

(2) A person commits an offense who recklessly, and without lawful authority or necessity to do so, discharges a firearm into the air, ground, a body of water, or any object in proximity to the person if the firearm is discharged at a place of public gathering or at a public event where there are at least twenty-five (25) people in attendance at the time of the discharge.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-103, is further amended by deleting subdivision (b)(4) and adding the following:

- (4) Reckless endangerment under subdivision (a)(2) is a Class C misdemeanor.
- (5) Reckless endangerment under subdivision (a)(2) is a Class E felony if the discharge of the firearm results in bodily injury, serious bodily injury, or death to another.
- (6) In addition to the penalty authorized by this subsection (b), the court shall assess a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) to be collected as provided in § 55-10-412(b) and distributed as provided in § 55-10-412(c).

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016, the public welfare requiring it.
