Mr. CONAWAY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To increase the number of operational aircraft carriers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN NUMBER OF OPERATIONAL AIR-**
4 **CRAFT CARRIERS.**

5 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following find-
6 ings:

7 (1) In light of the increased array of complex
8 threats across the globe, the Navy is operating at
9 maximum capacity, increasing deployment lengths,
10 and decreasing maintenance periods in order to meet
11 operational requirements.

1 (2) Deployment lengths now frequently extend
2 to 10 months, which places considerable strain on
3 personnel, equipment, and platforms.

4 (3) Upon return from deployment, units are
5 often placed in “surge status”, requiring them to
6 maintain high levels of readiness and to quickly re-
7 deploy if necessary.

8 (4) An additional carrier strike group would
9 give the Secretary of Defense greater flexibility in
10 deploying naval forces as well as increase forward
11 naval presence. It would also improve the health and
12 long-term service life of the existing fleet by pro-
13 viding for longer maintenance and repair time.

14 (b) INCREASE IN NUMBER OF CARRIERS.—Section
15 5062(b) of title 10, United States Code, is amended by
16 striking “11 operational aircraft carriers” and inserting
17 “12 operational aircraft carriers”.

18 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
19 subsection (b) shall take effect on September 30, 2023.
