SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5785

1 AN ACT Relating to the definition of official duties of state 2 officers; reenacting and amending RCW 42.52.010; and adding a new 3 section to chapter 43.01 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 42.52.010 and 2011 c 60 s 28 are each reenacted and 6 amended to read as follows:

7 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in8 this section apply throughout this chapter.

"Agency" 9 (1)means any state board, commission, bureau, committee, department, institution, division, or tribunal in the 10 legislative, executive, or judicial branch of state government. 11 "Agency" includes all elective offices, the state legislature, those 12 13 institutions of higher education created and supported by the state 14 government, and those courts that are parts of state government.

15 (2) "Assist" means to act, or offer or agree to act, in such a 16 way as to help, aid, advise, furnish information to, or otherwise 17 provide assistance to another person, believing that the action is of 18 help, aid, advice, or assistance to the person and with intent so to 19 assist such person.

(3) "Beneficial interest" has the meaning ascribed to it underthe Washington case law. However, an ownership interest in a mutual

1 fund or similar investment pooling fund in which the owner has no
2 management powers does not constitute a beneficial interest in the
3 entities in which the fund or pool invests.

4 (4) "Compensation" means anything of economic value, however 5 designated, that is paid, loaned, granted, or transferred, or to be 6 paid, loaned, granted, or transferred for, or in consideration of, 7 personal services to any person.

8 (5) "Confidential information" means (a) specific information, 9 rather than generalized knowledge, that is not available to the 10 general public on request or (b) information made confidential by 11 law.

12 (6) "Contract" or "grant" means an agreement between two or more 13 persons that creates an obligation to do or not to do a particular 14 thing. "Contract" or "grant" includes, but is not limited to, an 15 employment contract, a lease, a license, a purchase agreement, or a 16 sales agreement.

(7) "Ethics boards" means the commission on judicial conduct, thelegislative ethics board, and the executive ethics board.

19 (8) "Family" has the same meaning as "immediate family" in RCW 20 42.17A.005.

21 (9) "Gift" means anything of economic value for which no 22 consideration is given. "Gift" does not include:

(a) Items from family members or friends where it is clear beyond a reasonable doubt that the gift was not made as part of any design to gain or maintain influence in the agency of which the recipient is an officer or employee;

(b) Items related to the outside business of the recipient that are customary and not related to the recipient's performance of official duties;

30 (c) Items exchanged among officials and employees or a social 31 event hosted or sponsored by a state officer or state employee for 32 coworkers;

(d) Payments by a governmental or nongovernmental entity of reasonable expenses incurred in connection with a speech, presentation, appearance, or trade mission made in an official capacity. As used in this subsection, "reasonable expenses" are limited to travel, lodging, and subsistence expenses incurred the day before through the day after the event;

39 (e) Items a state officer or state employee is authorized by law 40 to accept; 1 (f) Payment of enrollment and course fees and reasonable travel 2 expenses attributable to attending seminars and educational programs 3 sponsored by a bona fide governmental or nonprofit professional, 4 educational, trade, or charitable association or institution. As used 5 in this subsection, "reasonable expenses" are limited to travel, 6 lodging, and subsistence expenses incurred the day before through the 7 day after the event;

8 (g) Items returned by the recipient to the donor within thirty 9 days of receipt or donated to a charitable organization within thirty 10 days of receipt;

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(h) Campaign contributions reported under chapter 42.17A RCW;

(i) Discounts available to an individual as a member of anemployee group, occupation, or similar broad-based group; and

14 (j) Awards, prizes, scholarships, or other items provided in 15 recognition of academic or scientific achievement.

16 (10) "Head of agency" means the chief executive officer of an 17 agency. In the case of an agency headed by a commission, board, 18 committee, or other body consisting of more than one natural person, 19 agency head means the person or board authorized to appoint agency 20 employees and regulate their conduct.

(11) "Honorarium" means money or thing of value offered to a state officer or state employee for a speech, appearance, article, or similar item or activity in connection with the state officer's or state employee's official role.

(12) "Official duty" means those duties ((within the specific 25 26 scope of employment of the state officer or state employee as defined 27 by the officer's or employee's agency or by statute or the state Constitution)) prescribed in the state Constitution and state 28 statutes, legislatively funded or mandated authority and 29 responsibilities, job description, or any tasks or actions related to 30 31 carrying out the activities of the state officer's position that are 32 intended to promote the state of Washington and protect, educate, and serve the citizens of the state of Washington. 33

(13) "Participate" means to participate in state action or a proceeding personally and substantially as a state officer or state employee, through approval, disapproval, decision, recommendation, the rendering of advice, investigation, or otherwise but does not include preparation, consideration, or enactment of legislation or the performance of legislative duties.

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(14) "Person" means any individual, partnership, association,
 corporation, firm, institution, or other entity, whether or not
 operated for profit.

4 (15) "Regulatory agency" means any state board, commission, 5 department, or officer, except those in the legislative or judicial 6 branches, authorized by law to conduct adjudicative proceedings, 7 issue permits or licenses, or to control or affect interests of 8 identified persons.

9 (16) "Responsibility" in connection with a transaction involving 10 the state, means the direct administrative or operating authority, 11 whether intermediate or final, and either exercisable alone or 12 through subordinates, effectively to approve, disapprove, or 13 otherwise direct state action in respect of such transaction.

14 (17) "State action" means any action on the part of an agency, 15 including, but not limited to:

16 (a) A decision, determination, finding, ruling, or order; and

(b) A grant, payment, award, license, contract, transaction,
sanction, or approval, or the denial thereof, or failure to act with
respect to a decision, determination, finding, ruling, or order.

20 (18) "State employee" means an individual who is employed by an 21 agency in any branch of state government. For purposes of this 22 chapter, employees of the superior courts are not state officers or 23 state employees.

(19) "State officer" means every person holding a position of 24 25 public trust in or under an executive, legislative, or judicial office of the state. "State officer" includes judges of the superior 26 court, judges of the court of appeals, justices of the supreme court, 27 members of the legislature together with the secretary of the senate 28 29 and the chief clerk of the house of representatives, holders of elective offices in the executive branch of state government, chief 30 31 executive officers of state agencies, members of boards, commissions, 32 or committees with authority over one or more state agencies or institutions, and employees of the state who are engaged 33 in supervisory, policy-making, or policy-enforcing work. For the 34 purposes of this chapter, "state officer" also includes any person 35 exercising or undertaking to exercise the powers or functions of a 36 37 state officer.

38 (20) "Thing of economic value," in addition to its ordinary 39 meaning, includes:

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(a) A loan, property interest, interest in a contract or other
 chose in action, and employment or another arrangement involving a
 right to compensation;

4 (b) An option, irrespective of the conditions to the exercise of 5 the option; and

6 (c) A promise or undertaking for the present or future delivery 7 or procurement.

8 (21)(a) "Transaction involving the state" means a proceeding, 9 application, submission, request for a ruling or other determination, 10 contract, claim, case, or other similar matter that the state 11 officer, state employee, or former state officer or state employee in 12 question believes, or has reason to believe:

13 (i) Is, or will be, the subject of state action; or

14 (ii) Is one to which the state is or will be a party; or

15 (iii) Is one in which the state has a direct and substantial 16 proprietary interest.

17 (b) "Transaction involving the state" does not include the 18 following: Preparation, consideration, or enactment of legislation, 19 including appropriation of moneys in a budget, or the performance of 20 legislative duties by an officer or employee; or a claim, case, 21 lawsuit, or similar matter if the officer or employee did not 22 participate in the underlying transaction involving the state that is 23 the basis for the claim, case, or lawsuit.

(22) "University" includes "state universities" and "regional
 universities" as defined in RCW 28B.10.016 and also includes any
 research or technology institute affiliated with a university,
 including without limitation, the Spokane intercollegiate research
 and technology institute and the Washington technology center.

(23) "University research employee" means a state officer or state employee employed by a university, but only to the extent the state officer or state employee is engaged in research, technology transfer, approved consulting activities related to research and technology transfer, or other incidental activities.

34 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.01 35 RCW to read as follows:

36 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, "official duty" 37 means those duties prescribed in the state Constitution and state 38 statutes, legislatively funded or mandated authority and 39 responsibilities, job description, or any tasks or actions related to

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1 carrying out the activities of the state officer's position that are 2 intended to promote the state of Washington and protect, educate, and

3 serve the citizens of the state of Washington.

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
