2013 WISCONSIN ACT

 $AN\ ACT\ \emph{to amend}\ 175.30$ of the statutes; $\emph{relating to:}\ \emph{purchases}$ or transfers of rifles or shotguns in other states.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 175.30 of the statutes is amended to read: 175.30 Purchase of firearms in contiguous other states permitted. It is lawful for a A resident of this state

or a corporation or other business entity maintaining a place of business in this state to <u>may</u> purchase or otherwise obtain a rifle or shotgun in a state contiguous to <u>other than</u> this state if the transfer complies with federal law and the laws of both states.
