Concealed weapons-military applicant.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to concealed weapons; providing a procedure
2 for applicants in military service outside the state to
3 apply for a concealed weapons permit as specified; and
4 providing for effective dates.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-8-104(d)(intro), (e)(i) and by
9 creating a new paragraph (v) and by creating a new
10 subsection (cc) is amended to read:

11

12 **6-8-104. Wearing or carrying concealed weapons;**
13 **penalties; exceptions; permits.**

14

1 (d) Except as provided in subsection (cc) of this
2 section, the application shall be completed, under oath, on
3 a form promulgated by the attorney general to include:
4

5 (e) The applicant shall submit to the division
6 through the sheriff's office in the county of the
7 applicant's residence:
8

9 (i) A completed application as described in
10 subsection (d) of this section or, if applicable,
11 subsection (cc) of this section;
12

13 (v) If applicable, the items listed in
14 subsection (cc) of this section.
15

16 (cc) The attorney general shall by rule and
17 regulation provide a procedure under which an applicant who
18 is in active military service outside the state of Wyoming
19 but otherwise meets the requirements specified in
20 subsection (b) of this section may apply for a permit to
21 carry a concealed firearm under this section without
22 appearing in Wyoming. Applications under this subsection
23 shall require:

(i) The items listed in subsection (d) of this section;

(ii) Proof of residency in a form acceptable to the attorney general that shows the applicant meets the requirements specified in subsection (b) of this section;

(iii) Certification of the applicant's active military service outside the state;

(iv) A notarized affidavit from the applicant testifying in writing that the statements in the application are true and accurate. The affidavit required by this paragraph subjects the applicant to criminal prosecution under W.S. 6-5-303; and

(v) Any other information required by rule and regulation of the attorney general.

Section 2. The attorney general shall promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement this act by July 1, 2016.

4 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
5 section, this act is effective July 1, 2016.

7 (b) Section 2 of this act is effectively immediately
8 upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become
9 law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
10 Constitution.
