Concealed weapons-military family applicants.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to concealed weapons; providing a procedure  
2 for family members of persons in active military service to  
3 apply for a concealed weapons permit as specified;  
4 requiring rulemaking; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-8-104(cc)(intro), (iii) and (v) is  
9 amended to read:

10

11 **6-8-104. Wearing or carrying concealed weapons;**  
12 **penalties; exceptions; permits.**

14 (cc) The attorney general shall by rule and  
15 regulation provide a procedure under which ~~an applicant a~~

1 person who is in active military service outside the state  
2 of Wyoming, or who is a family member as defined by rule of  
3 the attorney general residing with a person in active  
4 military service outside the state, but otherwise meets the  
5 requirements specified in subsection (b) of this section  
6 may apply for a permit to carry a concealed firearm under  
7 this section without appearing in Wyoming. Applications  
8 under this subsection shall require:

9

10 (iii) Certification of the ~~applicant's~~  
11 applicable person's active military service outside the  
12 state;

13

14 (v) Any other information required by rule and  
15 regulation of the attorney general, including proof of the  
16 familial relationship of the family member and the person  
17 in active military service outside the state, if  
18 applicable.

1           **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
4 Constitution.
